- 4. The eligibility criteria for KIP programmes is as under:
 - i. **Age:** The programme is open to youth of Indian origin (excluding non-resident Indians) in the age group of 18-30 years. Non Resident Indians (NRIs) are not eligible for KIPs.
 - ii. **Educational Qualification:** Minimum qualification required for participating in KIP is graduation from a recognized University/ Institute or enrolled for graduation.
