REQUIREMENT OF PROJECT MANAGER

India Ports Global Private Limited (IPGPL) is a joint venture company formed by Jawaharlal Nehru Port Trust (JNPT) and Kandla Port Trust (KPT), incorporated under the Indian Companies Act, 2013, as per directions of the Ministry of Shipping (MoS), Government of India for development of port projects overseas. The Ministry of Shipping has presently assigned IPGPL the task of equipping and operating Container / Multipurpose Terminals at Chabahar Port in Iran.

IPGPL wishes to appoint a full-time Project Manager to be stationed at Tehran as per details given hereunder:

Eligibility Requirements:

1. A recognized qualification in Marine related field or Maritime studies or equivalent.
2. Local Iranian / Indian person (based in Tehran) fluent in Persian and English languages.
3. Must have at least ten years of relevant experience in management of marine operations or marine and/or port projects. Preference will be given to experience in Iran.
4. Must have successfully executed minimum 3 shipping / port related projects in Iran or outside of value not less than USD 30 million.
5. Having Liaison experience with Government and local authorities. Accessibility / reach in Government will be an added advantage.
6. The Project Manager is expected to be competent and possess the skill, knowledge and ability to manage and coordinate with various stakeholders of the project effectively.
7. Retired persons from Port & Maritime Organization are also welcome.
8. Will have to operate from his home for at least first one year.
9. Salary about USD 3000 (payable in Rials) lump sum per month. Salary will be commensurate with qualification and experience.
10. Preferred age not more than 60 years.
11. Duration of employment 1 year + 2 years.

Responsibilities:

1. The Project Manager will be initially involved in all preparatory work for the execution of Contract signed for Equipping and operating two terminals at Chabahar port.
2. Project Manager will have the responsibility of setting up a liaison office at Tehran and later assist in establishing Project SPV office in Chabahar port.

3. Monitor and report on developments in Chabahar Free Trade Zone, which will impact the port traffic.
4. Monitor and report on transit facilities, rail and road connectivity developments, which will affect port traffic.
5. Monitor and report on trans-shipment facilities, which will affect port traffic
6. Monitor and report on Iran domestic trade through Chabahar Port.
7. Arranging visit visas for visiting delegations from India
8. Arranging visas and work permits, for personnel deployed by IPGPL, or SPV in future.
9. Arrange Customs formalities of equipment to be imported.
10. Report to IPGPL Management any significant local developments which may affect the project
11. Any other work as required by the Management.
